As a volunteer with Pet Safe Coalition Society of Canada, I agree to the following:

- a) To represent PSCS in a professional manner in the event that I volunteer.
- b) To follow the rules and procedures set up by PSCS during the event.
- c) To respect PSCS's right to terminate me as a volunteer should it be determined that I am in conflict with the goals of PSCS to help animals during an event. PSCS also has the right to terminate volunteers if it is determined to be a threat to their health and/or well-being.
- d) To return to PSCS any property belonging to the organization upon request.
- e) To use equipment and facilities belonging, or being used by PSCS in a manner not to damage or destroy them.
- f) To not represent PSCS to the media without approval of the PSCS Director/Coordinator in charge of the present event.
- g) To not abuse or neglect any animal in the care of PSCS at any time.
- h) To not cause bodily harm to any other volunteer, or other individuals cooperating with the animal disaster or relief efforts.
- i) Under no conditions will volunteers be allowed to bring guns, hunting type knives, or bows and arrows to the Reception Center or Animal Intake Centre located near any disaster headquarters or designated other locations.
- j) Alcohol and illegal drugs are not permitted to be used at anytime while volunteering with PSCS for the duration of an event. If a volunteer violates either, they will be dismissed as a volunteer.
- k) Smoking is not permitted in any area other than one that has been designated by the PSCS coordinator.
- l) All volunteers will adhere to the appropriate clothing and footwear rules while volunteering at an event.
- m) I understand that volunteering with PSCS can put me at risk for injury or death. I will not hold Pet Safe Coalition Society of Canada or any Pet Safe Coalition Society of Canada directors responsible should injury or death occur while I am a volunteer with the organization.
